

SAI undertaking a full revision of the SA8000 Standard for decent work

SAI – Social Accountability International is undertaking a full revision of the SA8000 Standard for decent work. SA8000 is SAI flagship certification program of SAI to advance human rights for workers around the world. It was established in 1997 as the first auditable labor standard.

As per SAI announcement "the purpose of this revision is to ensure that the SA8000 Standard continues to serve as a leading benchmark for ethical workplaces at all levels of the value chain, reflecting evolving human rights risks and good practices".

The draft standard is open for public comment, between September 16 to November 15, 2024. The consultation information and feedback form can be accessed on SAI Website here.
